There is No One Like Jesus

Hebrews 1: 1-4 (pew Bible pg. 1001)

In Exodus 33:20, God told Moses that no one can see God and live. Yet in 2 Corinthians 3:18, we read: "And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another." Paul is saying that in Jesus Christ, the veil is removed, and we are able to see the glory of God when we look at Jesus. If you want to see what God is like, to draw closer to Him and know Him, look to Jesus.

The message we have been talking about and singing about at My Life Matters this year is *There is No One Like Jesus*! That is what the writer of Hebrews shows us in today's passage. Hebrews 1 contains several life-changing, eternity changing, facts about Jesus. If you've heard the message before, hear it again....and worship. If you've never heard this message, hear it today, and be changed. There is no one like Jesus!
