Psalm 119: 161-168 [Sin and Shin] (pew Bible pg. 516)

Sin and Shin **161** Princes persecute me without cause, but my heart stands in awe of your words. **162** I rejoice at your word like one who finds great spoil. **163** I hate and abhor falsehood, but I love your law. **164** Seven times a day I praise you for your righteous rules. **165** Great peace have those who love your law; nothing can make them stumble. **166** I hope for your salvation, O LORD, and I do your commandments. **167** My soul keeps your testimonies; I love them exceedingly. **168** I keep your precepts and testimonies, for all my ways are before you. Psalm 119:161–168

Love for God and His Word Shapes My Heart 119:161-163

What I fear – my heart stands in awe of your word

What I value – *like one who finds great spoil* 

What I love – I hate and abhor falsehood, but I love your law

Love for God and His Word Directs My Life 119: 164-167

Constant praise – seven times a day I praise you

Consistent peace – great peace have those that love your law

Love for God and His Word Fuels My Obedience 119:168-169

Patient as I obey - I hope for your salvation .... and I keep your commandments Determined to obey

- I keep your precepts and testimonies

Secured of God's omniscience as I obey - all my ways are before you
