How We Pursue Discipleship Together: Perseverance

1 John 5:7-21 (pew Bible pgs. 1023-1024)

God's gospel agenda unfolds as God's \underline{P} eople \underline{P} roclaim the Word of God in the lives of others, in \underline{P} rayerful dependence on the Spirit and in **P**erseverance.

What does perfect, holy perseverance look like? à The steadfast love of God > Perseverance is the fruit of conviction that is anchored in the steadfast love of God. > Conviction becomes anchored in God's steadfast love only through abiding in it.
