### **Engaging Our Culture with the Gospel** Acts 17:16-34

Now while Paul was waiting for them at Athens, his spirit was provoked within him as he saw that the city was full of idols. Acts 17:16

> Paul's experience in Athens is revealing, and should cause me to ask, "What is a worldview; what is mine?"

Paul's perspective & response to the culture of his day should cause us to ask, "What do I see and how does it make me feel?"

Paul's different approaches to sharing the gospel should cause me to ask, "How can I better speak gospel truth into my culture?"

> Paul's gospel message was oriented toward his audience, and should cause me to ask, "How can I do the same?"

Application questions: (during this sermon series we will consider these each week)

What is your worldview and how is it shaped by the gospel?

What does our culture say about IDENTITY, and how can I speak the gospel into this search for identity.

What does our culture say about life, and how can I speak the gospel into this search for the understanding and value of life?

What does our culture say about finding fulfillment, and how can I speak the gospel into this search for a full and flourishing life?

# Be (Consider)

### What does God's Word lead me to prayerfully consider? In your journal, use the following questions to write some prompts to use in praying through this week's passage.

Is there a command to obey? How am I compelled to exalt God? Is there a promise to claim? Is there a principle to follow? Is there an example to follow? Am I convicted to confess any sin? Is there a sin to avoid? How do I need to rest in Jesus/the gospel? How can I pray for someone else? What am I compelled to love or desire?



How does God's Word call me to yield my life? In your journal, write your answers and thoughts in response to the following questions.

What would you say are the factors that most shape your posture to the culture around you? How much is the gospel an influence?

How equipped would you say you are in sharing the gospel with others? How confident are you in sharing the gospel in different contexts in *meaningful* ways?

How is the Lord prompting you to pray as begin to walk through this part of this series together?
