## **Sermon Notes**

## A Stark Contrast that Points Us to Christ

1 Samuel 2:12-36

In the first section of I Samuel 2 we hear the song of a faithful mother. Hannah praises the Lord and declares "there is none holy like the LORD". In the next section of chapter 2, we begin to see the son of a faithful mother as Hannah's son, Samuel, begins to serve and minister "in the presence of the LORD". Samuel is described as a boy who is growing "in stature and in favor with the LORD and also with man."

In this passage we see two other sons who are a picture of unfaithfulness, who, although they are priests, are described as "worthless" and are infamous for their corruption and contempt for God. What we will discover in this passage is a stark contrast that, in the end, points us to Christ, "a faithful priest who shall do according to what is in [God's] heart".
