Sermon Notes

God Is Not Silent

1 Samuel 3:1-21

The Context: Spiritually speaking silence and darkness characterize the day, but there is a flicker of hope.

And the word of the LORD was rare in those days; there was no frequent vision.

The lamp of God had not yet gone out, and Samuel was lying down in the temple of the LORD, where the ark of God was. 1 Samuel 3:1b & 3

The Call: God is not silent – He personally intervenes and reveals through his Word.

And the LORD came and stood, calling as at other times, "Samuel! Samuel!"

And Samuel said, "Speak, for your servant hears." 1 Samuel 3:10

The Certainty: God's sure word determines the destiny of his people individually and collectively.

Then the LORD said to Samuel, "Behold, I am about to do a thing in Israel at which the two ears of everyone who hears it will tingle. 1 Samuel 3:11

The Continuation: God will continue to speak and none of his words fail.

And Samuel grew, and the LORD was with him and let none of his words fall to the ground.

And all Israel from Dan to Beersheba knew that Samuel was established
as a prophet of the LORD. 1 Samuel 3:19–20

Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, Hebrews 1:1–2
