Sermon Notes

Responding to God's Holy Presence

1 Samuel 6:1-7:1

In today's passage, both the Philistines and the Israelites living in Beth-Shemesh discover

that the reality of the presence of God is not to be taken lightly. God is holy, and that has great ramifications for how we—especially as sinners—respond and relate to him. Over the last few chapters in 1 Samuel, we have seen that God will not allow himself to be anyone's good-luck charm (ch 4) or trophy (ch 5), and now we will see that he will not allow himself to be anyone's novelty. We will also be reminded that right response to God is rooted in right knowledge of God . Circumstances might lead us to ask the right questions, but we must look to God alone and submit to him alone in the response of our lives to him.
