Sermon Notes

God's Plan to Anoint His King

1 Samuel 16:1-13

Who's the man?! God begins to work out his plan to replace the lame duck king with the shepherd king - from a selfish king who wanted the glory to a servant king who would point to the King of Glory.

I'm going to introduce someone who probably doesn't need an introduction. David is one of the key figures in all of scripture. In just this passage, we see David as the son of Jesse, the youngest brother, the runt, the better neighbor who would take Saul's place, shepherd, the anointed prince of Israel, the musician, the armor-bearer, the servant, the Spirit-filled king, the warrior, and God's king for God's people.

We meet David and in a lot of ways, man he's a hero! But if you look closer, you'll see there's only one hero! And there's only ONE True King for God's people. David knew that, and that's a clue as to why he was God's man for the job.

God always makes provision for His plan.

God's perspective - He sees the heart.

God's presence - The Spirit moves, and the servant king serves.
