Sermon Notes

Grounded, Growing, Going.

That All the Earth May Know Part 2: Faith in Action 1 Samuel 17:12-47

These two verses are critical to our understanding of what we see unfolding in 1 Samuel 17.

"Do not look on his appearance or on the height of his stature... For the LORD sees not as man sees: man looks on the outward appearance, but the LORD looks on the heart." 1 Samuel 16:7

And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him. Hebrews 11:6

The natural tendency for every one of us is to look at outward appearances. With our physical eyes we see people, circumstances, etc. and then, based on those observations, we make assessments, form opinions, make decisions and then respond accordingly. But seeing with physical eyes is very different than seeing with eyes of faith.

Eyes of faith see everything through the reality of God – his existence, his power, and his promises. Faith sees through the eyes of the heart - with a spiritual perspective that enables us to endure and overcome like the saints who have gone before us. "By faith [Moses] left Egypt, not being afraid of the anger of the king, for he endured as seeing him who is invisible" (Heb. 11:27). In other words, to live by faith is not to live by what we can see and feel and touch — on the basis of our sense-experience — but to live on the basis of what God has said and promised.

Today in 1 Samuel 17, David steps into the spotlight. The day begins for him in a very normal way, by the end of the day his life will be totally changed, as will the life of the nation of Israel. All this will occur because David, being filled of the Spirit of God, hears, sees, and acts according to a spiritual perspective that is based not on what he sees with his physical eyes, but on what he sees with the eyes of faith. There is much we can learn as we observe David's faith in action.
