## Whose Kingdom?

1 Samuel 18

With the swing of a sling and the flight of a rock everything changed for Israel and David. He was no longer obscure and unknown. He was a rock star! :) Everyone loved David,.....well, almost everyone. Saul was concerned for "his" kingdom, his glory, and his power. David was concerned for God's glory and his own duty to God's Kingdom. We see quite a contrast in how Saul responded to David and what God was doing and how his family and all of Israel responded. David was the anointed King that God had chosen for Himself. He was "a messiah" and a deliverer for Israel. What we see is the difference between God-centered lives & a self-centered life.

- 1. A God-centered life is characterized by love and godly relationships A self-centered life is characterized by hate and selfishness
- 2. A God-centered life demonstrates godly wisdom, a self-centered life is consumed by bitter jealousy and selfish ambition
- 3. A God-centered life seeks to serve and bless others A self-centered life looks to use, manipulate, and harm others
- 4. A God-centered life is empowered by God's presence and experiences God given success A self-centered life creates enemies and is consumed by sin and fear
