### The King Who Can Declare, "God is My Helper" 1 Samuel 23

Last week we saw the stark contrast between the two "kings". This week the divide between them is even greater, providing the backdrop to see the ever-increasing contrast between Saul and David. One seeks the Lord and His guidance; the other listens to himself and various unbelievers. One seeks to save, the other seeks to destroy. One is encouraged in the Lord by faithful friends who are willing to risk all for the sake of their covenant commitment; the other is alone in his sin and motivated by self-interest. One is hunted yet protected by God; the other is the hunter who is prevented by God from harming God's anointed.

In three separate incidents in 1 Samuel 23, we see how David is protected by the Lord in different ways, so that when he reflects on this season of his life, he can proclaim, "Behold, God is my helper; the Lord is the upholder of my life" (Psalm 54:4).

The King Who Saves and Is Saved: Guided and Held by the Hand of God (1 Samuel 23: 1-14).

The King Who Is In Difficulty and Needs Encouragement: Strengthened in God Through the Hand of a Friend (1 Samuel 23: 15-18)

The King Who Is Betrayed and Needs Deliverance: Sovereignly Protected by the Hand of God (1 Samuel 23: 19-29)
