Sermon Notes

The Terrible Yet Beautifully Necessary Presence of God ² Samuel 6

David not only sought to identify Jerusalem as the political center of the nation, but also as the religious center. The religious center would be found where God's presence resided; therefore, the ark needed to be brought and placed there. But, as the story of the ark's passage to Jerusalem unfolds, we see the profound juxtaposition found in God's presence that confronts us all concerning this truth of God's holiness: His presence is not at all safe for anything unholy, yet his presence is infinitely beautiful, and absolutely necessary for life and flourishing. What we learn from this difficult chapter is the truth that God intends for his people to dwell in his presence, but his people can do that only by being in right relationship with him. And it is only in Christ that we can dwell in his terrible yet beautiful presence.

3 vitally important reminders for us from 2 Samuel 6:

1. God is **HOLY**. (v. 3-11)

2. God is **GOOD**. (v. 12)

3. God is **WORTHY**. (v. 13-23)
