Sermon Notes

God's Covenant With David – Pt 2

2 Samuel 7:11-17 (pew Bible pg. 259)

When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring after you, who shall come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son. When he commits iniquity, I will discipline him with the rod of men, with the stripes of the sons of men, but my steadfast love will not depart from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away from before you. And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever.” In accordance with all these words, and in accordance with all this vision, Nathan spoke to David. 2 Samuel 7:12–17

*I will sing of the steadfast love of the LORD, forever;
with my mouth I will make known your faithfulness to all generations. For I said,
“Steadfast love will be built up forever; in the heavens you will establish your faithfulness.”
You have said, “I have made a covenant with my chosen one; I have sworn to David my servant:
‘I will establish your offspring forever, and build your throne for all generations.’” Psalm 89:1–4*

David's days will end, but his dynasty will not.

David's desire to build God's house is denied, but it will be built by David's son.

David's son's will receive God's discipline, but God's covenant love will never depart.

David's imperfect sons can't fulfill the promise, but the eternal Son of David will reign forever.

Applications:

God's covenant invitation through David is for you. Accept it. (Isaiah 55:1-3)

God's covenant blessing through David is for all nations. Share it. (Jeremiah 33:22)

God's gracious blessing through David is eternal. Live it. (Isaiah 9: 7)
