2 Samuel 7:18-29

The disciples needed Jesus to teach them how to pray (Luke 11:1). So do we. And today the Lord gives us a much-needed lesson on prayer from his servant David. God's Word to Us Should Draw Us Into His Presence
Then King David went in and sat before the LORD 2 Samuel 7:18

God's Word to Us Should Prompt Us to Praise God For What He Has Done
Because of your promise, and according to your own heart,
you have brought about all this greatness, to make your servant know it. 2 Samuel 7:21

God's Word to Us Should Cause Us To Praise God For Who He Is
Therefore you are great, O LORD God. For there is none like you, and there is no God
besides you, according to all that we have heard with our ears. 2 Samuel 7:22

God's Word to Us Should Prompt Us To Pray Back To God His Promises And now, O LORD God, confirm forever the word that you have spoken concerning your servant and concerning his house, and do as you have spoken. 2 Samuel 7:25
