The Answer: ....he took three javelins in his hand and thrust them into the heart of Absalom while

he was still alive in the oak. And ten young men, Joab's armor-bearers, surrounded

Absalom and struck him and killed him.

Question 3: What should be the response here? (2 Sam 18:31 - 19:8)

The Answer: "Good news for my lord the king! For the LORD has delivered you this day from the

hand of all who rose up against you" ...........And the king was deeply moved and

went up to the chamber over the gate and wept.

In David's Greater Son there is refuge and grace available for rebels (Psalm 2:12, Luke 15:20)

The pain and grief of sin is all too real; there is only one place of certain comfort (2 Cor 1:3;ff)

We have the instruction & wisdom we need in this messy complicated world (Ps 119:105, 130)
