# Honor, Respect, and Purity Within the Family of God

1 Timothy 5:1–6:2 (pew Bible pgs. 992-993)

Westwood Baptist Church is not a corporation. We are not a company. What we are within the church is a family. We are the household of God (1 Tim 3:15). With God as our Father, we are a family of adopted children, brought into a love relationship with God and our spiritual siblings by his grace through Jesus Christ our Lord. "In love he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons [and daughters] through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will" (Eph 1:5).

Therefore, we are to act like a family, we are to function like a family, and we are to treat one another as family. Earlier in 1 Timothy, Paul said, *I am writing these things to you so that...you may know how one ought to behave in the household of God, which is the church of the living God, a pillar and buttress of the truth* (1 Tim 3:15). In today's passage, we have specific instructions about how we are to behave, how we are to lift up and support the gospel, and what we see applies to everyone in the church family regardless of our age, our season of life, our position in the church, or our employment status.

Relate to all members of the church family appropriately, differently, but always with honor and respect. (5:1-2)

Care for and honor all members of the church family, especially the widows in need. (5:3-16)

Honor and support everyone in the church family, especially the elders who rule well and work hard. (5:17-25)

Honor and respect all members of the church family for God's glory and the gospel's advance. (6:1-2)
