Sermon Notes

Unashamed and Ready to Suffer - The Gospel is Worth It

2 Timothy 1:7-12 (pew Bible pg. 995)

Are you embarrassed to be associated with Jesus? We have no reason to believe that Timothy had already been ashamed of Paul and the Gospel, but he was obviously being tempted. Being "ashamed" involves doubt and uncertainty. "Shame" has more to do with how we believe we are perceived by others and how we are being treated by them. You can be shamed by others into feeling and acting ashamed. Timothy was struggling. Stronger men than Timothy had wilted under the weight of shame and suffering.

God wants us to be unashamed as we live and share the Gospel and to suffer well for the Gospel's sake.

Jesus said, "The world has hated and persecuted me, Your Master, so you know it's going to hate and persecute you, my servants" (my paraphrase of John 15:18,20). But Jesus also said that even thought you will have trouble in this world, take heart! **I have overcome the world**. (John 16:33)
