Isaiah 9:6-7 (pew Bible pg. 573)

Long before the people were given a King, God promised to send a King. This King would rule not just Israel, but all the nations. One of the central themes of the Old Testament is the coming King who would rule over an eternal Kingdom. This morning we will look back at King David and King Solomon and consider again how they pointed forward to the King of Kings, King Jesus. It is the Lord Jesus Christ that Paul called “blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords...”. He is the Only eternally enthroned King who is worthy of all honor and praise.
