Sermon Notes

The Ultimate Showdown on Mount Carmel

1 Kings 18 (pew Bible pg. 299-301)

King Ahab and Israel thought their biggest problem was the drought and famine. Elijah shows up to powerfully demonstrate that the drought was just a symptom and consequence of their real problem. They have too many gods. There is only one true God. If God is God, then everything in life is affected by that reality. If God is all powerful and righteous, the giver of all life and sovereign over everything, then to ignore Him is not just sinful, it's foolish.

God desires to be known. He is righteously jealous over His people. When we are in sin, God will go to great lengths to bring us back to Himself. What we see in this passage is one of the greatest displays of power ever witnessed by man. It's also an incredible demonstration of God's mercy and His grace. Everyone on Mount Carmel came to know something of God's power, His righteous judgement, and His grace. And it all came down to this: "If Yahweh is God, follow Him."
