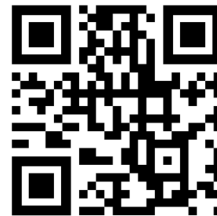

2 Kings 3-4

The book of Kings shows us again and again that Israel's God is the one true God. The Lord raises up Elisha as His prophet to remind Israel that blessings come with obedience and discipline comes when they stray. Elisha's name means, 'My God saves.' And through Elisha, God not only calls His people to faithfulness but also displays His faithfulness. The message behind these miracles in our passage is clear: our God saves—He is real, He is powerful, and He is compassionate—so we can trust Him completely!
