2 Kings 12

King Joash's life began with such promise. Rescued from death, raised in the temple, and guided by a godly priest, his story was marked by grace from the beginning. Yet, as the years passed, his faith began to fade. What started as a season of renewal in God's house turns into a tragedy of neglect and compromise. But through it all—through faithfulness and failure alike—God's grace keeps working. Human faithfulness may falter, but God's covenant grace never does.
