INTRODUCTION

Illustration: The *Mission Impossible* movies.

1. BECAUSE GOD IS THE ONLY ONE WHO CAN TURN THE ORDINARY INTO THE EXTRAORDINARY.

“And Mary said to the angel, ‘How will this be, since I am a virgin?’” (Luke 1:34).

2. BECAUSE GOD ACTS ACCORDING TO HIS WORD IN A WILLING HEART.

“And Mary said, ‘Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word.’ And the angel departed from her” (Luke 1:38).

3. BECAUSE GOD IS THE ONLY ONE WHO CAN DO GREAT THINGS IN HUMBLE PEOPLE.

⁴⁶ “And Mary said,

“My soul magnifies the Lord,

⁴⁷ and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior” (Luke 1:46-47).

CONCLUSION

Brothers and friends, may we come to know and meditate on the Great Mystery of the Incarnation of Christ Jesus this Christmas, which has been revealed to us.
