When Faith Is Under Siege

2 Kings 18:13–37

When faith is under siege, the enemy attacks and questions who we trust - so God's people must stop listening to the lies and bring their fears to the Lord.

This passage exposes the strategies of the enemy and the proper reflex of faith.

So why does that matter for you and me? Because we are in a spiritual battle. - fear still speaks loudly, temptation still markets itself as rescue, and pressure still reveals what or who we really trust.
